What do I do? How do I enter?

To get involved, you need to tell us how you have been (and continue to be) a *Kaitiaki for Te Awarua O Porirua*. We would love to hear it from you, so come and join us at Pataka on the 21st of November (from 12.30pm-2.30pm) where students from all over Porirua will present to each other about their kaitiaki projects.

We know that good things take time, so all projects will be considered – even those that are not yet “complete”.

You may have been involved in an action project to help protect and enhance the rivers, harbours or coast of Porirua – in which case you should definitely tell us what you’ve been up to!

Actions may have had a direct impact on the environment to help solve or prevent harm to the marine or freshwater environment, OR could be about encouraging others to make choices that will help our local environment and harbour.

Kaitiaki projects need to be:

- In the Porirua Catchment area
- Reached outside the classroom or involved the community in some way
- Be focused on a marine, harbour or freshwater conservation issue that is of concern to you.

To enter simply join us at Pataka education rooms on the 21st of November and present to us about your project. We would love to hear how you have achieved (or plan to achieve) your kaitiaki goals.

The best presentations will also be invited to share at the public presentation day on the 2nd of December at 3.30pm

You can:

- make a powerpoint or google slides presentation or get a little more creative...
- Include props, videos, photos, art, music
- share written stories, poems about Porirua and the natural environment, your experiences in HHP, or taking action

During judging we will consider:

- Your communication and understanding about why you have taken the action you planned.
- Your creativity, presentation, and demonstration of leadership and commitment to the project
